

Can obtain maximum benefit from the Bekotaş Spray Paint (Fasarit), must be removed from accordance mortar,raw concrete,cement gypsum board and made ceiling paint, dirt, dust and adhesion surfaces. Should be cleaned worm, swollen, completely perforated plate of paints.

- If there is not particular a new object to be painted like grain mortar, concrete, cement must be smoothed with satin plaster. If necessary, surface craks shold be filled with putty and defects should be corrected.
- Best way to take advantage from Bekotaş Spray Paint (Fasarit) after making all surfaces smooth to apply. Bekotaş Spray Paint (Fasarit) will reduce consumption and ensure good adhesion.
- Should be cleaned old painted moldly surfaces on the wall before application with damp cloth. Thoroughly with emery paper, the surface must be removed. If soot and mold drying preemptive 2-3 coats should be applied.



## **Application**



During application and during the subsequent 24 hours at the ambient temperature of the surface should be +5 C.



Before application Bekotaş Spray Paint should be mixed.



Bekotaş Spray Paint thinned with clean water 10% and application for two layer by brush, roller or spray.



Should be waited minimum 6 hours between layers.




